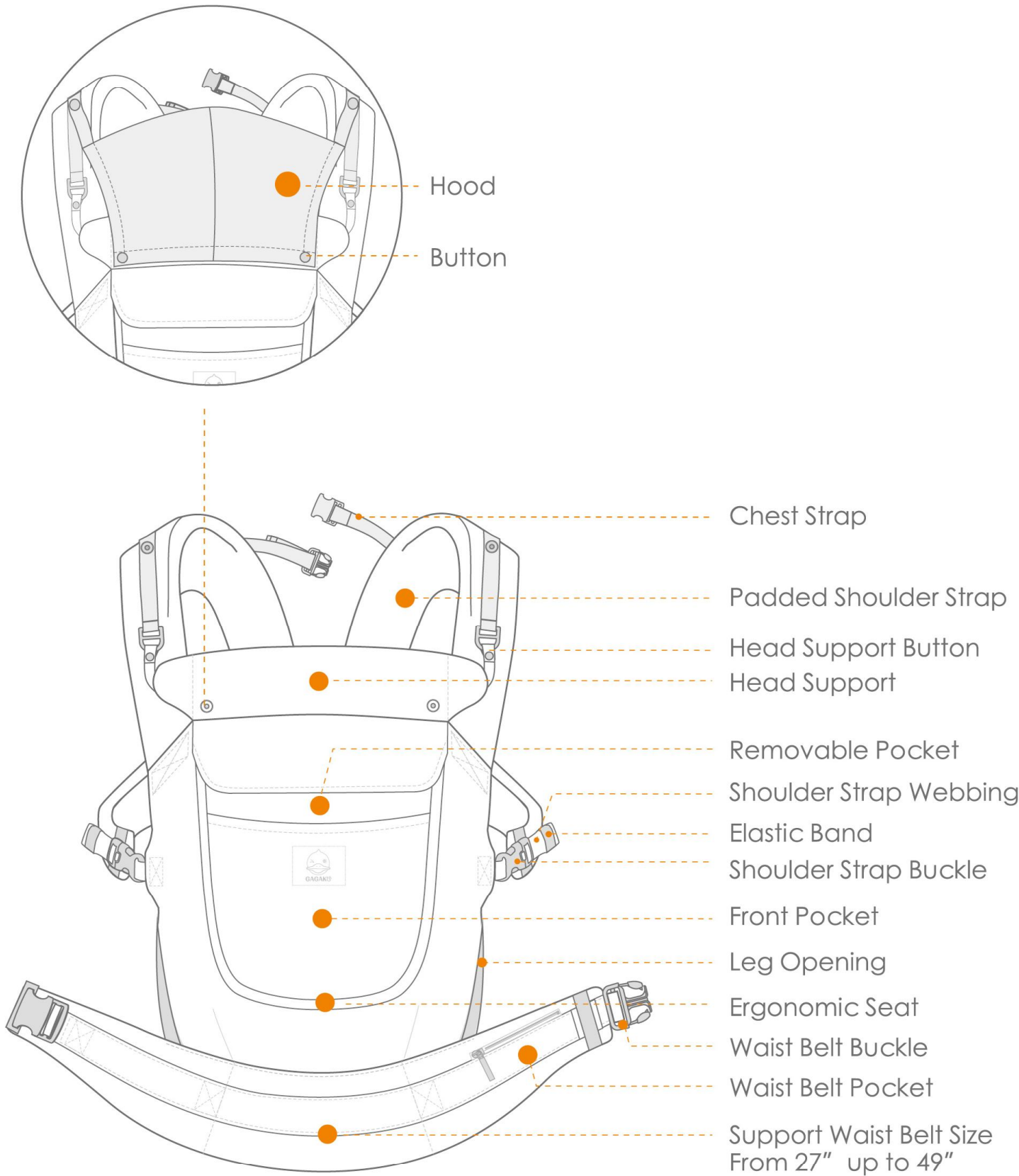




Instruction Manual — Baby Carrier

Product Overview



**Read all instructions before assembling and using your carrier.
Keep the manual and review them before attempting new carrying positions.**

Instructions for Two Different Carrying Positions

Notes for all instructions

- The carrier parts can be found on the product overview.
- Try it before placing the baby in the carrier.
- Have another adult to assist you for the first time.
- Ensuring the Waist Belt fits securely and comfortably to your body at all times.
- Hold your baby securely during the whole process until all buckles and straps are properly fastened and adjusted.

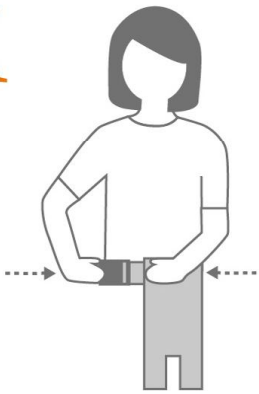
Front carrying position of Facing-In & Facing-Out

Note

If your baby fall asleep in Facing-IN Position, you should adjust the baby's head to rest on your chest with the face turned to the left or right. If in Facing-Out Position, change it to Facing-IN Position or follow the instructions and remove the baby to a comfortable place.

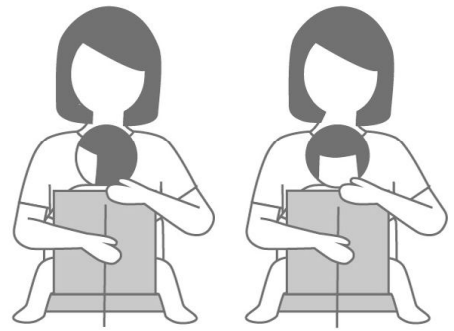

Buckle the Waist Belt and adjust. Hold the carrier with the interior facing you.

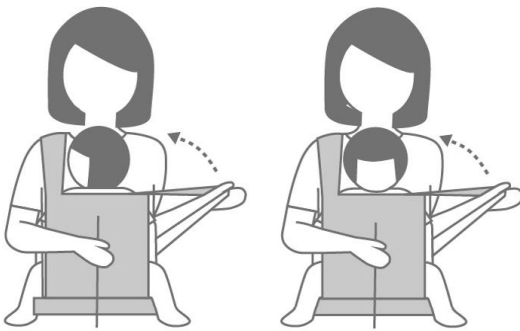
Note: Adjust the height of the Waist Belt, according to you own figure.

Hold your baby with face-in or face-out. Keep baby's legs around your waist in Face-In Position. Keep baby's back close to your chest in Facing-Out Position.

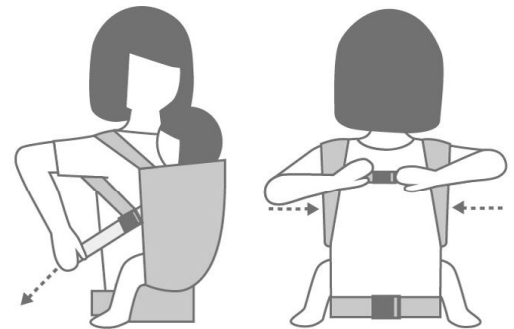

Hold your baby with one hand, and place the other arm through the Shoulder. Keep holding your baby while wearing the other Shoulder Strap.

Note: Ensuring baby is placed in the center of the carrier with arms and legs extended.

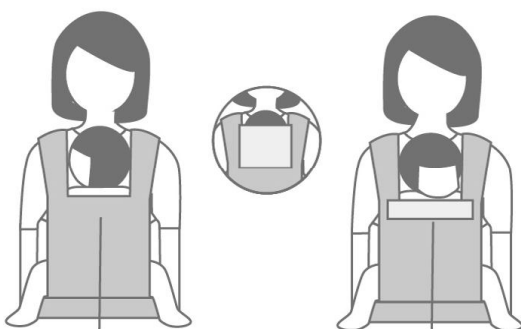

Adjust the hanging part of the Shoulder Straps to form a comfortable position. Buckle the Back/Chest Strap to tighten.

Note: There should always be room between baby's face and your chest to provide a clear source of air.

Button the Head Support to protect the baby's head and neck. If in Facing-Out position, you can remove the Head Support for a better view for your baby. Button the Hood, when a shelter is needed for the baby.

Removing Baby from the Carrier - Facing In/Out Position

Notes

Never unbuckle the Waist Belt while your baby is in the carrier.

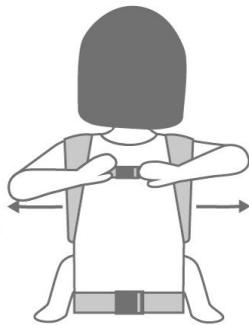
Hold the baby throughout the process.

Always support baby's head in an upright position during the process.

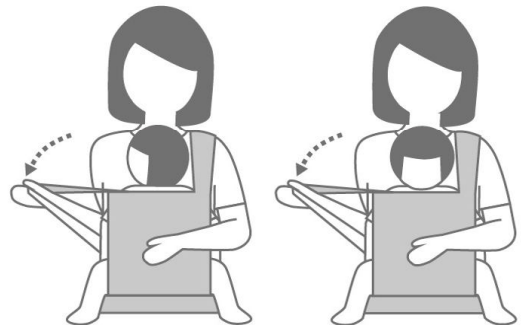
Avoid any potential hazards or obstructions when removing baby from the carrier.

Instructions

- 1** Keep one hand securely on your baby, and release the Back/Chest Strap.

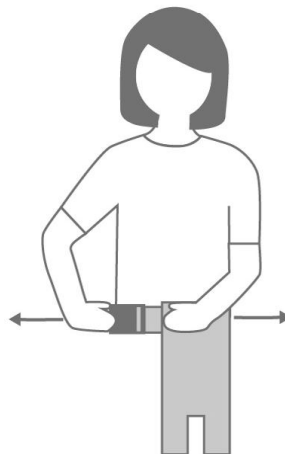
Keep holding your baby, and loosen the shoulder strap.

- 3** Lift your baby with both hands and place him/her in a safe location.

Remove the carrier by releasing the Shoulder Straps and Waist Belt.



Back Carrying Position

Notes

Baby must be able to fully sit up on his/her own to use the Back Carrying Position.

We recommend always having a partner to assist you with Back Carrying Position.

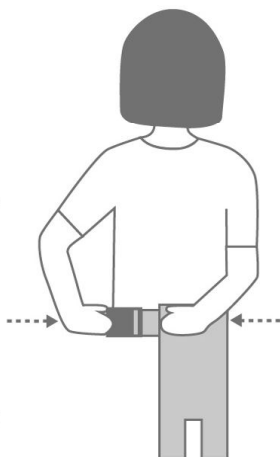
If baby falls asleep, please follow the instructions, and remove the baby to sleep in a comfortable place.

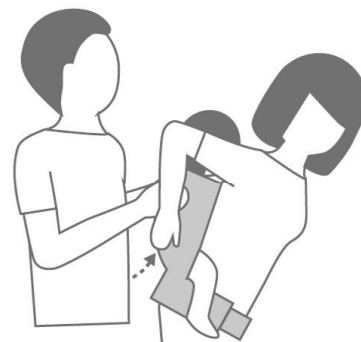

Buckle the Waist Belt and adjust. The carrier should be hanging down behind you.

Note: Adjust the height of the Waist Belt, according to your own figure.

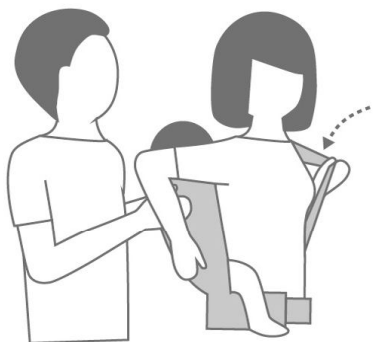

Once the Waist Belt is properly fitted, lean forward slightly and have your partner lift baby up and place him/her on your back. Keep baby's legs around your waist.

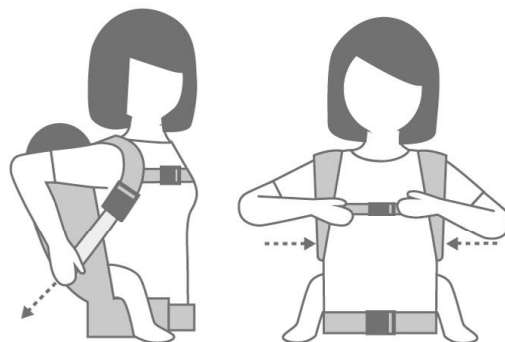

With your hands supporting baby, have your partner pull the carrier body up over baby's back and help you to wear the Shoulder Straps.

Note: Ensuring baby is placed in the center of the carrier with arms and legs extended.

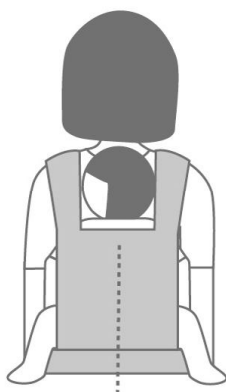


Adjust the shoulder straps and buckle the Back/Chest Strap. Have your partner button the Head Support.

Note: There should always be room between baby's face and your back to provide a clear source of air.

Once the carrier is securely buckled and adjusted, your partner can remove the support of baby.



Removing baby from the Carrier - Back Carring Position

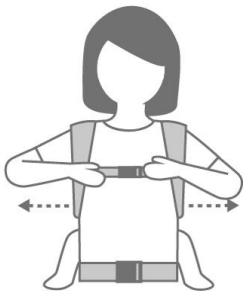
Notes

Never unbuckle the Waist Belt while your baby is in the carrier.

Always support baby's head in an upright position during the process.

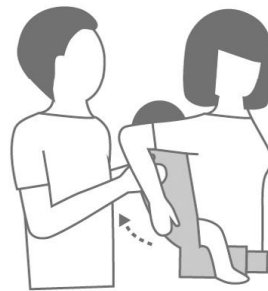
Avoid any potential hazards or obstructions when removing baby from the carrier.

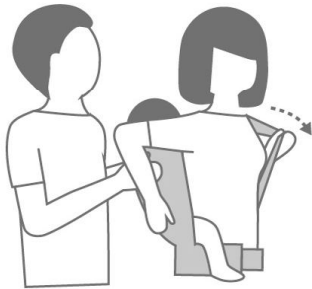

Slightly loosen the Shoulder Straps.



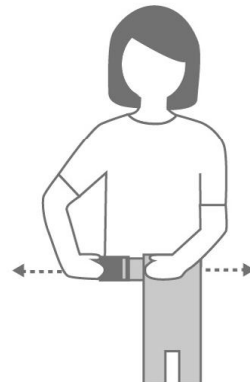

Your partner can now lift the child from the carrier.

Have your partner release the Head Support Buttons while holding the baby.

Release the Back/ Chest Strap, the Shoulder Straps and Waist Belt to remove the carrier.

Warning

- Do not use this product if deterioration or breakage problems are detected.
- Never leave baby unattended in this carrier.
- Always check to ensure all parts of the carrier are secure before each use. Never use the carrier while engaging in activities that involve a heat source or exposure to chemicals.
- This carrier cannot restrain your baby in sudden crash.
- Small children can fall through leg openings. Only use this carrier for children between 12lb (5.5kg) and 33lb (15kg). Children between 7lb (3kg) and 12lb (5.5kg) must use the carrier with infant insert.

Tips for Maintenance

- Do not iron.
- Do not use dryer. Natural air-drying only.
- Do not use bleach and fabric softener when cleaning.
- Regular care is limited for spot cleaning with a damp cloth. Wash if it is absolutely necessary.
- We recommend machine wash separately, with cold water in gentle cycle mode.

Warnung

- Benutzen Sie das Produkt nicht wenn Sie eine Veränderung in der Benutzung oder einen defekt bemerken.
- Lassen Sie Ihr Baby niemals unbeaufsichtigt in der Trage.
- Überprüfen Sie alle Teile der Trage bevor Sie sie benutzen um Sicherzustellen das alles in Ordnung ist.
- Benutzen Sie die Trage nicht wenn Sie mit einer Wärmequelle oder mit Chemikalien arbeiten.
- Diese Trage kann Ihr Baby bei einem Unfall nicht schützen. Benutzen Sie sie nicht in einem Fahrzeug.
- Kleine Kinder können durch die Beinöffnungen fallen. Benutzen Sie daher bitte die Trage nur für Kinder von 12lb (5.5kg) bis 33lb (15kg). Wenn Sie die Trage für Kinder zwischen 7lb (3kg) und 12lb (5.5kg) benutzen wollen, benutzen Sie zusätzliche bitte den Säuglingseinsatz.

Tipps zur Pflege

- Benutzen Sie kein Bügeleisen.
- Benutzen Sie keinen Trockner, lassen Sie den Stoff an der Luft trocknen.
- Benutzen Sie keine Bleiche oder Weichspüler.
- Vermeiden Sie den Stoff immer komplett zu Waschen. Eine punktuelle Reinigung mit einem feuchten Tuch reicht in dem meisten Fällen aus und sorgt für eine längere Benutzungsdauer.
- Wir empfehlen Ihnen den Stoff separat zu waschen. Benutzen Sie bitte einen kalten Waschgang und eine sehr geringe Schleudernzahl.
